Description: Youth ages 16-18 (as of May 1, 2008) who would like to serve alongside Texas 4-H Conference Center Counselors and Program Assistants to provide a safe and fun camp experience for all.

4-H Camp Mentors reside in the dorms and participate in all camp activities. As a Mentor, they may be asked to work individually with campers needing special attention or with the entire group. Mentors will shadow the 4-H Center Staff and be available to assist in whatever capacity that is needed.

Mentors are expected to be flexible and willing to help where needed. Mentors will be used during County Camp IV and Prime Time I and II.

Registration fee \$125: includes dorm lodging, meals and snacks for the two week period, July 13—July 26.

Application Process: This leadership opportunity is open to all current 4-H members, ages 16-18 (as of May 1, 2008). To be considered as a 4-H Camp Mentor, individuals must complete the enclosed application form and return to the Texas 4-H Center by May 15, 2008. 4-H members will be notified of their acceptance as a Mentor and receive additional information.

Application must be signed by County Extension Agent, or if completed and returned by e-mail, please have agent send an e-mail to dlocke@ag.tamu.edu certifying your 4-H participation and his or her recommendation for you to serve as a 4-H Conference Center Mentor.
